SAFETY AND OTHER INFORMATION

- **Physical Exam.** A physical is required for all V & H drivers/riders.
For drivers/riders up to and including 69 years of age, a physical is required every two years.
For drivers/riders 70 years of age and older, a physical is required every year.
Participants are required to carry either a hard or electronic copy of the physical at each event site to ensure compliance when requested. Use the APBA or other approved physical form.
- **SMBC Membership.** Drivers and riders must be current members of the SMBC or another APBA associated club to be on the water. SMBC 2026 membership is \$40.
- **APBA Membership.** To be permitted on the water, you must be a member of the American Power Boat Association and minimum age of 16. You are responsible for showing that you are an APBA member. The Registrar cannot accept outdated cards. Please contact APBA if you have not received a current card. Single event memberships of \$100 will be available at registration.
- **Pit Entry - Crew Membership.** The pit area at Piney Point and Leonardtown are designated as “Hot Pits”. The only persons allowed to enter the Hot Pits must be: a Racing member of APBA, a Non-Racing member of APBA, or a Single Event Crew Member of APBA. APBA Single Event Crew Memberships are available at registration for \$25.00 each. Every person, regardless of age, is required to have an APBA membership to enter the Hot Pits.
- **Waiver of Liability.** All participants must sign an APBA approved waiver of liability and release form. Parents or guardians of minors must sign a waiver and release form. If a minor will not be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to a race, the Minor Release may be completed by the parent or legal guardian off-site.
- **Invitation Only.** This is an invitation only event. All boats must be pre-registered and inspected.
- **Safety Inspection.** All boats must be inspected prior to being allowed on the water. Inspections will take place on Friday from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. It is the responsibility of the Owner/Driver to contact an inspector. Have all safety equipment available. You must sign the APBA safety inspection sheet with APBA number or APBA single event membership number. Kill switches are mandatory. Secondary throttle return springs must be present. Turnbuckles must be safety wired. Fire extinguishers (3A40BC), minimum 5 lbs., must be readily accessible in the hot pit area. ALL props must be covered in the hot pit area.

- **Driving Safety.** Only owners of boats will be allowed to drive unless they have prior approval from the Event Referee at the event. All drivers must sign the APBA Entry Form for the boat in which they are riding. Any unsafe operation of boats will be addressed.

- **Consumption of Alcohol.** No one shall participate on the water, nor shall any official serve in an official capacity, after having consumed alcohol or controlled substances, or while intoxicated. Consumed shall mean from midnight before the day of the event. The Referee will have an approved portable breathalyzer onsite. Crew members are not exempt. Direct any driving safety concerns to the Vintage Representative at the event.

- **Personal Safety Gear.** Helmets and jackets must be consistent with APBA approved guidelines. Goggles, face shields or V&H approved eyewear required. Drivers must wear appropriate driving gear with long sleeves, long pants and closed toe shoes. **All crew must wear closed toe shoes in the pits.**

- **Pit Safety**
 - No engines running with propeller or hardware on prop shaft.
 - No smoking or alcohol permitted in the hot pit area during the event.
 - Only active APBA Drivers, Officials, and APBA members are allowed in the hot pits.
 - No firing of engines during the lunch break when pits are open to the public.
 - Pets in the pits must be leashed at all times.
 - Please stay aware at all times.
